You are responsible for keeping your pets and children off of the ponds. They should not play near or on the frozen ponds as it is not safe.


Helpful Hints:

CHOCOLATE KISSES SNOWBALL COOKIES



Ingredients:

1 cup butter, softened

- 11/2 cups powdered sugar, divided
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp pure vanilla extract 1 cup walnuts, very finely chopped
- cup walnuts, very linely choppe
- 1/2 tsp kosher salt
- 2 tbsp water
- 24 chocolate kisses, unwrapped

Instructions:

1- Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Line two baking sheets with parchment paper

2- In a large bowl using a hand mixer, cream together butter and 1/2 cup powdered sugar. Fold in flour, vanilla, nuts, salt, and water

3- Mold 1 tbsp cookie dough around each chocolate kiss and roll into a ball. Chill for 1 hour

4- Transfer to prepared baking sheets and bake for 20-25 minutes, until cookies look dry and have not taken on any color

5- Cool cookies for 20 minutes, then roll in remaining 1 cup powdered sugar

If you leave for the holidays, make sure to leave your thermostat set at **no less than 60 degrees** to avoid frozen pipes.
